#### Safe Cycling completed

- 2. For the whole school to ride around the 2 bays at Kawakawa Bay and have a lunch/ sausage sizzle to finish the unit off. All juniors completed the ride.

Dave and I had been very happy in the lead up to these two events. The skills and confidence the pupils were showing at school with our unit were achieving the goals we had set out to achieve. It was great to have all our pupils on bikes with helmets and to see pupils riding every break and lunch time to keep improving with their skills and fitness plus their growing knowledge of bikes and cycling in general. They were also having a lot of fun.

A huge thanks to Jason our community constable and the parents who acted as marshals for the senior road trial on the Wednesday. For a number of pupils it was the first time they have ridden on our local road. The senior pupils who never made a mistake will be awarded their Road License at Friday's assembly. However, the confidence that all pupils gained by getting out on the road is awesome.

Again we thank all the parents and helpers who got 43 pupils and bikes over to Kawakawa Bay on Friday with special thanks to Keith who took his truck and trailer. It was wonderful to see the whole school riding on the road and how well the seniors looked after the juniors. The seniors in their review rated this as one of the most satisfying parts of the study-great to see them enjoying and relishing their leadership responsibilities. Thanks to Andrea C for the BBQ lunch which was a great way to finish the unit. All personal bikes/helmets should be back home by the end of this week. We are very happy for pupils to still use school bikes to enjoy cycling at school. Shane has sprayed the old cycle track so we can build up our fitness for the Triathlon.

#### **School Athletics**

We now have a 2 week block building up to our school athletics on Friday 25 November. We will get the high jump going, long jump pit dug and running tracks mown. We will also practice the throwing skills of shot, discuss, Frisbee or gumboot depending on pupil's age. It will be our last Inter-House competition for the year so we hope we can get heaps of parents to support and cheer our athletes on. We start at 10.30 (when the weather is cooler) and finish approx. 12.45-1.00pm

It is certainly a busy time of year and with the earthquake and tsunami warnings it has been a very eventful week.




We have had a number of students away sick with the bugs that have been going around. It is definitely best to keep your child at home if they are sick.

In Maths we have been learning about fractions- halves and quarters.




